NC PPS/PPSB Qualification – SO/RO/RSO/Instructor/Trainer COF Cheat Sheet RIFLE – STANDARDS DRILL

Target must be full-size LE/Police "B-27 Silhouette" (24"x45").

ALL stages start with the safety ON, standing, "low ready".

All sighting systems are allowable as long as they have NO MAGNIFICATION. Scopes must be capable of – and set to – Zero-Times (0X) or removed from the gun.

ALL position transitions: finger off the trigger AND safety ON.

Bolt action rifles: add 5 seconds for all but the last drill.

Exact round magazine loading: 9, 4, 6, 6, 5, (2 handgun) (this loading allows for the "long walk" to be with "cold" guns)

Stage 1 – 50 yards – 9 rounds (1 9-round magazine)

Stage 2 – 25 yards – 12 rounds (1 4-round magazine, 2 6-round magazines)		
Double Tap (Standing)	2	3
Emergency Reload (Standing – must be "emergency")	2 + Reload + 2	12
Standing to Kneeling	2 + 2	7
Stoppage (Malfunction, Standing, empty chamber)	Dry Fire + Tap-Rack + 2	7
Stage 3 – 15 yards – 6 rounds (1 chambered + 3-round magazine from above – move "hot", 1 5-round magazine)		
Body Armor – Last shot must be a headshot	2 Body + 1 Head	5
Emergency Reload (Standing – must be "emergency")	1 + Reload + 2	12
Stage 4 – 10 yards – 3 rounds (1 chambered + 2-round magazine from above – move "hot")		
Body Armor – Last shot must be a headshot	2 Body + 1 Head	4
Stage 5 – 7 yards – 2 handgun rounds (bolts closed on empty, safety on after Stage 4)		
Transition to Handgun (Standing)	Dry Fire Rifle + 2 (handgun)	5

Scoring:

- All 32 rounds must be on the silhouette
- The two headshots "should be" the only two in the head area. 28 of the rounds are "large target" center-mass.

Tips:

- Score each stage separately so that if a person needs to "reshoot" they only have to reshoot that stage.
- Make sure all 30 rifle rounds are accounted for before the 2 handgun rounds.

All three "Courses Of Fire (COF)" must be passed as follows in one out of three attempts for an Officer to get certified in Rifle/Carbine:

- Standards Drill: Pass/Fail All 32 rounds on the silhouette within the time limits is a "pass"
- Day and Night COF: 80% or better (3-4-5 method times 2 divide by 3) with all 30 rounds on the silhouette
